Distinguished Alumni Award

Seth Dvorin Distinguished Young Alumni Award

The LAA's Seth Dvorin Distinguished Young Alumni Award was created in 2004 in memory of Army First Lt. Seth Jeremy Dvorin '02 (Administration of Justice), who was tragically killed in Iraq on February 3, 2004. The award is presented to Livingston College young alumni who are 30 years old or younger who have distinguished themselves by contributions they have made in their chosen fields of endeavor, by the leadership they have exhibited, and by the general benefits to the larger society resulting from their activities. Past recipients include Kevin Apuzzio LC'06, Gregg Spiridellis LC'93, and Karen Rogers LC'92.

Livingston Legacy Award

The Livingston Legacy Award was established in 2008 to recognize Livingston College faculty and staff that played a key role in the establishment and growth of Livingston College and its mission, and contributions to the overall Rutgers and global communities.
