The Rutgers **Young Alumni Ski Trip to Lake Placid**, the winter sports capital of the world, will leave Thursday evening, January 25, 2007 — giving everyone **two whole days, plus three-quarters of Sunday to ski, shop, or tour the area**, and return on Sunday January 29. Also by popular demand, we have arranged for special **Friday night toboggan races on Mirror Lake**. It's all included with your ski package!

Lake Placid is nestled in the northeastern portion of the Adirondack wilderness of New York State. The Olympic facilities used for the 1932 and 1980 Olympic Winter Games, Santa's Workshop, Highfalls Gorge, and other tourist attractions make this area a fabulous resort for everyone. **Besides skiing and skating, there are museums, theaters, and plenty of places to explore.** The accommodations are at

- indoor heated pool
- sauna
- steam room
- Jacuzzi, health club
- racquetball court
- nightly entertainment at Tiffany's Lounge and dancing at Roomers Nightclub.

Activities within the town of Lake Placid include:

- dog sledding
- snow tubing
- ice skating at the Olympic Oval
