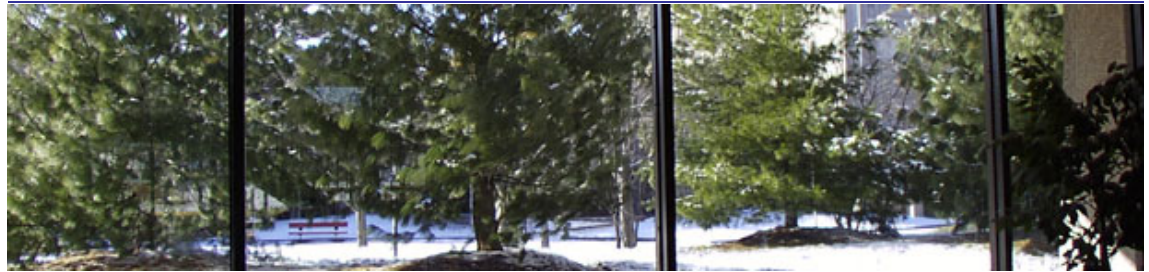

###### General

- Livingston College's [36th annual commencement convocation](#) was held May 19 at the Louis Brown Athletic Center. This was the largest graduating class in the college's history, with 864 students earning degrees. Of these, 108 graduated in October, 172 in January, and 584 in May, with 496 earning B.A. degrees and 80 earning B.S. degrees. There were 103 students who completed multiple majors and eight who completed dual degrees.
- Livingston College launched a redesign of its [Web site](#) in early May, created primarily by Jay Garrett, LC '03 (design) and Kevin Grigorenko, RC '06 (technical programming), working in conjunction with Tamar Kieval Brill, Assistant Dean for Special Projects and web master.
